Clinics and Hospitals

International SOS and the U.S. Center for Disease Control and Prevention selects the Jiangsu Provincial Hospital as a recommended site for medical care. This is also the closest hospital to Nanjing Normal (南师大) and Wu Tai Hua Yuan (五台花园). If you need to go to a hospital, please contact a YISA staff member to help translate and also help guide you around. At Chinese hospitals, you have to move between many departments so it can be rather confusing. Chinese

hospitals work on a cash basis so you will need to provide payment at the time of care. The good news is that the cost of care is very inexpensive. Larger amounts can be reimbursed by your insurance company (InsureAmerica). If you are not sure if you need to see a physician, you can call the 24 hour International SOS Hotline to speak to a physician in English to obtain a medical evaluation.

This small but clean clinic is the regular dental office of several foreign schools. You can get teeth cleaning for 100-200 rmb. The Dentist, Dr. James Ji understands some English. They also do major work (crowns, root canals) for a reasonable price. A YISA family member had a crown placed without a problem.

Located in the Hunan Lu dining area Shizi Qiao, this restaurant serves decent Thai food and is popular with Nanjing's expats. A golden Buddha statue outside greets arriving guests, while the decor inside is tasteful and subdued. Besides the typical solid curries and pad Thai, Golden Harvest features several specialties, including a good fried crab with Thai curry sauce and a casserole of baked king prawns with vermicelli noodles.

Chinese Cuisine

Nanjing Da Pai Dang 南京大排档

This restaurant is a must visit restaurant. Da Pai Dang has classic Nanjing cuisine in a Qing Dynasty teahouse atmosphere. There are three locations (including Shiziqiao at Hunan Lu), but the Deji Plaza store is the newest and nicest. Try the Pao Jiao Ji (Marinated Spicy Chicken), the egg fried rice, and the extra large dumplings. Reasonable prices: 30-60rmb per person.

Beijing Duck is sliced roasted duck served with thin tortillas, plum sauce, sliced cucumbers, and green onions. It's like a Chinese version of fajitas using roast duck. The restaurant is very busy and the price is very reasonable. They serve other dishes besides duck, but it is the duck that you go to this restaurant for. They duck bones are used to cook a soup and they will give you a coupon for a free Beijing Duck on your next visit.

Anleyuan Muslim Restaurant 清真安乐园菜馆

With several locations throughout the city, this chain dumpling place is tasty and very inexpensive. Some students have dubbed it "Dumpling Heaven". The menu is in Chinese but sometimes if you ask they might have a translated version on a scrap of paper. This is China's version of fast food, but the dumplings are well made.

Although the outside needs some work, the inside is a nicely decorated old teahouse. This restaurant specializes in northern Jiangsu province dishes that aren't too oily.

This is the great entertainment and a meal all wrapped up in one. They serve spicy Sichuan food while the actors perform "bianlian" or "changing faces", a traditional Sichuan performing art. There aren't shows every night so be sure to call ahead.

Theaters

There are very few theaters in Nanjing. However, there are a lot of performances in universities, colleges and in local communities, so just keep your eyes open for flyers or postings.

Museums, Historic Sited and Parks

There are too many places to see in Nanjing and the surrounding areas to describe, but here are a few. Nanjing has a lot to offer in terms of ancient traditions and history, but it is also a booming modern city. Parks are an important feature of the landscape in Nanjing and each one has its own charm and identity. No matter what you are in the mood for, either padding down China's past or enjoying a friendly paint ball match in the park, Nanjing offers it all.

Museums and Historic Sites

Nanjing historically is a very important city. The capital during the early 20th century, it has always been an integral part of China. China's amazing rate of growth and urbanization can be seen here in Nanjing. Skyscrapers line the streets pushing out buildings where old traditions lie. Nanjing is a juxtaposition of modern and traditional, where Wal-mart is around the corner from a Buddhist scripture press that still carves text on wooden blocks by hand.

Confucian Temple 夫子庙

This ancient examination center were used by scholars studying Confucian classics for civil service exams often bustling with shoppers and vendors selling trinkets of all kinds. At the heart of the complex is the temple.

Jinling Buddhist Scripture Press 金陵刻经处

This traditional Buddhist scripture press houses one of the biggest collections of wooden blocks. Every wooden block was and is today still carved by hand. This is an impressive collection. You may call ahead for a guided tour, but be sure that you are confident with your Chinese or have a translator with you.

Nanjing Aviation Martyrs' Memorial 雨花台烈士纪念馆

In 1994, the names of 3,000 plus pilots who gave their lives in the War of Resistance against Japanese both Chinese and American were added to the tombs on the cemetery.

Nanjing Folk Customs Museum 南京民俗博物馆

Don't let the name of the museum fool. You won't see a lot of folk customs here. However, the architecture of the mansion that houses the museum is interesting and there is a small hands-on toy section that is interesting.

Nanjing Massacre Memorial 南京大屠杀纪念馆

This is a memorial to all who were killed during the Rape of Nanjing during the Japanese invasion in 1937. It will be closed for renovations until December, 2007 when a newly renovated memorial will be opened to the public. This is one of the most well known museums in China.

This is a great glimpse of the history and art of China. The lacquer and jade exhibits are particularly good.

The institute demonstrates the high skill and difficulty involved in this traditional craft. Only 4—5 centimeters a day is produced of the fine silk. Guided tours in English are available.

Presidential Palace 总统府

The buildings were once home to government officials of Sun Yatsen and Chiang Kai-shek. There are several outdoor restaurants and a museum of modern Chinese history and traditional Chinese culture. There is also a model palace of Hong Xiuquan, the leader of the Taiping Heavenly Kingdom Rebellion.

Taiping Heavenly Kingdom Rebellion Museum 太平天国历史博物馆

Right next to the Confucius Temple, it houses one of the nicest gardens in Nanjing. The Taiping Rebellion from 1851-1864 was the second bloodiest war in human history (behind only WWII). The Taiping leader Hong Xiuquan believed he was the younger brother of Jesus Christ. The Taiping's rebelled against the Manchus (Qing Dynasty), and consisted mostly of working class poor.

Jiming Si (Rooster Crow Temple) 鸡鸣寺

The active Buddhist monastery is situated on a hill with a pagoda overlooking the city wall and Xuanwu Lake.

Linggu Si (Beamless Hall) 灵谷寺

This old temple includes a famous vault architectural feature with a beamless brick arc.

Pilu Si 毗卢寺

Less of a tourist attraction than Jiming Si but still worth a visit. There is also a vegetarian restaurant right outside called Just Vegetarian.

Parks

There are too many parks to be named and too many activities and attraction at each park to mention. Here are just a few with some of the attractions that they offer. If you are looking for a specific garden to activity, come to the office and I can either steer you in the right direction or find out as much information as possible.

Bailuzhou Park and Bird Marekt 白鹭洲公园与花鸟市场

From the White Egret Park there are a series of hills, lakes and beautiful pavilion. Just to the north of the park, you will find Nanjing's biggest bird, fish, insect and pet market.

Baima Park 白马公园

This park features a peacock farm and old "bixie" statues. There is a paddle boat pond and assortment of amusement rides.

Botanical Gardens 中山植物园

Located at the base of Purple Mountain, there is a large bonsai garden and an inviting amusement park. It is best to enjoy the amusement park when it's hot because you are likely to get quite wet.

This versatile park has everything. From paint ball to Nanjing's biggest peony garden. There is even a place to grill that comes with hot coals, a grate and skewers if needed. Just bring meat and you can even buy beer at the park and you've got the makings of a great afternoon. There is even a secret way to enter for free!

There are pretty wooded trails that leads to an annual mini theme garden of fighter jets and artillery pieces. There is also a pigeon feeding pavilion.

Hanzhongmen 汉中门

To get a great view of the park and the canal, walk up the city wall. This is a good place to watch kite flying.

Jiuhuashan Park 九华山公园

Just past the Chan Temple, to the pagoda on the ridge, you will see the most spectacular view of Nanjing's skyline.

Mochouhu Park 莫愁湖公园

There are dragon boat races periodically and plenty of things to do to make you feel like a kid. For instance, free roaming bumper cars.

Xuanwuhu Park 玄武湖公园

There are trails for running, biking or roller blading throughout this park. There several islands in the middle of the lake where you will find aviaries, playgrounds and shops. There are electric boat rides around the islands where you might find herons, kingfishers and other interesting animals.

This 323 meter long staircase leading to the tomb is a hike and is better reserved for cooler days

than hot. However, once you reach the top, the view alone is worth the trek not to mention the tomb.

Zixia Lake 紫霞湖

Just east of the Ming Tombs at Purple Mountain, many locals, although there are signs preventing this, plenty of locals go swimming in this lake on hot summer days. The scenery around the lake provides a great atmosphere for a picnic.

Hotels

If family or friends are coming to visit, there are a wide variety of hotels to choose from. There are many luxury hotels available as well as budget conscious hotels to choose from.

Jin's Inn 金一村

This is a low cost hotel chain that is clean and modern. It is similar to the hotels we stay when we travel to Shanghai and elsewhere. There are several locations around Nanjing. The closest is located on Wu Tai Shan.

Parkview Dingshan Hotel 丁山花园大酒店

Intersection of Cha ha er Lu and Huju Lu 察哈尔路与虎踞路交叉口

This has been the primary hotel for the officials of University of Arizona. It is not very conveniently located to the rest of the city but luxurious at a decent place. There is a great buffet on the first floor with a seafood buffet on Friday nights.

Transportation

Getting around the city is easy. There are taxis, starting at 9 RMB for the first 2km, buses, and the subway. You can purchase a card and put money on it to use for buses, the subway and even some taxis for a reduced price. The card is called Jinglin Tong(金陵通). You can get it at Huaxia Bank (华夏银行) and it costs 30 yuan. You can put money on it at Huaxia Bank or at some of the main subway stops, like Xinjiekou, Zhujianglu and Xuanwumen. When you go to Huaxia Bank to get the card, you have to fill out a form in Chinese, so you might want to call Zhang Fan to help you.

Taxi

Taxis are convenient and can be picked up virtually anywhere in the city. The hours between 5:15p.m.—6:30p.m. is the shift change for virtually all taxis. So trying to get a taxi at this time can be extremely challenging.

Nanjing Metro Line

This is one metro (subway) line that runs north and south. The southern stop is the Olympic Stadium and it goes as far north as Maigaoqiao. Eventually there will be another line extending

north to the No. 2 bridge over the Yangtze river. There are several stops in town of interest and a convenient inexpensive way to get around—as long as you are going north and south.

Leaving Nanjing

There is a shuttle service from downtown Nanjing to the airport and back. The shuttle operates daily between the hours of 6:00a.m. and 7:30p.m.. Tickets may be purchased at the bus station or in the airport bus office. The shuttle office is located at Zhonghuamen Bus Station. The shuttle takes about 1 hour to the airport and the return shuttle takes about 5 different stops (Yuhua Square, Zhonghuamen, Shuiximen, Hanzhongmen and Caochangmen) and ends near the intersection of Shanghai Lu and Hankou Lu.

Shanghai Pudong Airport 上海浦东机场

Most international flights leave out of Shanghai. If you don't have a lot of luggage, taking the train to Shanghai is easy, fast and inexpensive. Once in the Shanghai Train Station, you can take a bus from the train station to the airport for 20rmb.

However, if you have a lot of luggage, there is a bus that leaves the Jinling Hotel every morning that will take you directly to the airport in Shanghai. Although the bus takes between 4—5 hours, the ride is pleasant and the bus is clean and comfortable. There is a short lunch break of about 20 minutes at a bus stop where there is a small convenient store and several small snack shops.
